3) Declarations under Code of Conduct:

Cllr Martin declared a personal interest in Item 11

4) Minutes

It was **resolved** to approve the minutes of the previous meeting of the Parish Council of Monday 14 November 2011 and these were signed as an accurate record of the meeting.

5) Adjournment of up to 15 minutes for members of the public to raise matters

Ann Bentley and Tracey Ward of Upton Cross informed the meeting of their intention to drive a project to develop the recreation area at Jubilee Field, having been inspired by a similar development at Golberdon. They have received offers of support from those who had achieved the Golberdon project, and suggested that a public meeting should take place in the New Year to include a presentation from Jackie Easton. Ann and Tracey expressed the importance of the project being in the hands of a community group comprising a cross-section of the parish as well as other community groups, local business, the school, and the police. Members expressed since regratitude for the offer and made further suggestions of those who may lend support, such as Zoe Harris in Dobwalls and Terry Leech of WestCountry Housing. It was **agreed** to set up an open meeting, to invite Jackie Easton to give a presentation, and to liaise with the clerk who would help to co-ordinate.

Two members of the public departed the meeting

6) Reports from and matters of concern to:

- a) PC Garth Hatt/PCSO Anslow/PACT clir: it was reported that the 'Have your say' panel discussed the community land trust, heard that a farm watch scheme has been set up, and listened to a talk from one of the County dog wardens who are targeting various areas to enforce dog-related laws. Crime statistics for November are as follows: i) possession of cannabis near Caradon mast ii) assault in Henwood iii) theft of metal attachments from tractor in Upton Cross. There were two reported crimes in the same period 2010. The police have warned that there have been many thefts of metal in the outlying area.
- b) Cornwall Councillor Turner: NB this Item followed Item 7

CC IIr Tumer announced there would be no caps on parish precepts for 2012-13. The recent proposal by County to pass to the Parish Council the responsibility for the public conveniences at Minions has been rescinded but only temporarily. He has also been looking into problems of drainage in the highway at Higher Rillaton farm. CC IIr Turner informed members that he had £12,000 available for

a major project in the Ward and proposed that it be used to resolve the problem of car parking in Upton Cross.

7) Finance

a) Cash flow of accounts It was resolved to approve the cash flow statement and this was signed by the Chairman.

CCIIr Turner arrived at the meeting

- Play area Jubilee Field: it was **resolved** to approve the cost related to replacing the post but not to undertake work to the concrete drains. It was felt that the position of the drains may need to be reconsidered.
- clerk appraisal: it was **resolved** to approve the proposals of the staff appraisal group as follows: the role of Clerk/RFO to be amended to Spinal Column Point (SCP) scale 18 24, the top SPC of 24 being available only on the achievement of the CLCA qualification; an annual increment to SCP 19; an increase in working hours to 43 permonth; all amendments to take effect from 1 September 2011.

The meeting received a list of items detailing problems, and it was **agreed** to remove temporarily the picnic benches from the field as they were being used inappropriately, and Clr Hopes kindly agreed to place a notice in the Link to explain the removal. CCIIr Tumer kindly agreed to speak to a Highways' official to get the traffic cones from the island removed.

a) It was **resolved** to approve an extension of 3 years from today the position of trustee to Cllr Martin and Cllr Masson. Cllr Terrett agreed to look at the details of the investment with a view to standing as one of the two vacancies still to fill. Cllr Daniel also volunteered to stand for one of the vacancies. Cllr Martin expressed her view of the importance of appointing a trustee with professional banking/investment experience and suggested an approach to the National Volunteer Bureau, and offered to draft a notice for the Bureau.

It was **agreed** to convene an open meeting on Wednesday 11 January at 7.00pm in Linkinhorne Parish Hall, and to invite community groups in the parish in order to coordinate efforts and ensure that it will be a community-ledevent/s.
